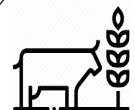


# STAKEHOLDER OPINION ON PLANS AND PROGRAMS



Artificial insemination program should focus on use of recognized Indian breeds.

Develop a pig breeding policy.



Coordinate with agriculture department to ensure availability of feed and fodder for animals.

Control use of antibiotics in commercial farms.



Take programs to prevent in-breeding in *khutis*. Facilitation of inter-state movement of animals can help in this connection.

Collaborate and initiate programs for focused skilling of people in livestock business.



Set up model livestock farms ( suitable to the location ) in each block in collaboration with panchayats. Strengthen these farms as breeding units to meet the local need of quality animals.

Ensure availability of essential medicines in dispensaries.



Engage with panchayat leaders for successful implementation of programs.

Issue Kisan Credit Card at subsidized interest rate to help livestock farmers buy day to day requirement for his / her farm.



Ensure availability of fodder seeds, silage in local market.

Give adequate importance to small ruminants, pigs and backyard poultry as same is more important for poor households than large animals.



Facilitate import of good quality animals to Assam from other parts of the country.

Monitor physical livestock markets regularly.



Register livestock farmers dispensary wise.
