
VETERINARY SERVICE AND INDIA'S COMMITMENT TO ADDRESS GLOBAL CHALLENGES.





We need to strengthen veterinary service as an enabler of trade in animal and animal products.






We need a National Veterinary Service mandate and guideline to help states cooperate and compete


India embracing a model of cooperative, competitive federalism.

Predominance of Mass centric discontinuous service




In the majority of cases, a veterinarian operates alone without any groups of animals assigned to him/her. The continuous delivery of service is difficult under such circumstance. Only limited accountability is possible in such a delivery approach. In areas showing growth, there is a fast emergence of service delivery through an annual contract. (e.g. veterinary service by cooperatives, private companies, Government-NGO partnership model etc.)





Predominance of curative focus






Predominance of symptomatic treatment (Inadequate awareness of the benefit of proper diagnosis using services of laboratories)



Examples of areas of strengthening and restructuring

Service mandate.

/ Organizational structure / divisions.

Service delivery arrangements.

Cadre structure, recruitment norms and career progression.

Balancing the workload of personnel.

Practice regulation and occupational standards.

Private participation in clinical service / extension.

Norms for data sharing and outsourcing of public service.

Examples of changed approaches

Increased focus on Human health role of Veterinary Service.

Focus on Mobile Veterinary, IT-based extension, holistic breeding and trade linked services.

Realistic production targeting instead of ICMR consumption guideline alone.

Balanced focus on unique production system and traditional medicines.

Balanced targeting of all sectors and players of value chain beyond livestock farmer.

 Balanced species focus. Functional allocation of the budget instead of species-wise allocation.

Key investment needed to support new service structure

Key investment needed to support new service structure. (Contd.)



Information Technology based solutions for service management, communication, capacity building and veterinary service / extension delivery.

Assistance to states for the restructuring of veterinary service delivery (ASRVS) – Suggested components.

Support for OIE-PVS selfevaluation and development of vision cum road-map for the restructuring of service delivery. Support for detailed cadre review, Organizational Development Exercise and Skill mapping / workforce assessment of professionals / field workers. Development of national model guideline, service information and learning management system for the use of service providers (Public / Private)

Support for fixing of indicators, improved data generation, reporting, and IT application in service delivery.

Support for pilot activities for private sector participation in service delivery. Setting up of project management unit for coordination, planning, and handholding of change process.







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
